Association with a great number of volunteers, as well as a Board dedicated to safeguarding and preserving the Sand Lake Area community and its natural environment.

While I have been Chair for less than a year, a number of initiatives have commenced or continued - several of them Association *firsts*. The establishment of a trial Nature Preserve on the Association's Buckley's Beach property is a first, as is the decision by the membership to be active participants in an OMB appeal (PL170627) aimed at curbing the excessive expansion of campsite development at Edgewater Park Lodge. SLAPOA has also made representations to Kearney Council on issues relating to the Official Plan (OP), particularly as it relates to a proposed new re-zoning bylaw. The Board, as per a 2014 Association resolution, has provided funding to engage a planner who will provide advice relating to the OP - Jim Skelton has been doing an excellent job leading SLAPOA's efforts in this area.

The Board has also begun developing a strategy for the creation of a special action fund to ensure the Association can continue to be a strong advocate for our Members while maintaining a solid financial footing well into the future. Although we have increased our membership over the last year, we are also continuing to explore ways to attract new people and encourage participation, including the creation of an improved electronic membership form.

Further, I extend my thanks to Wilson Boynton and his team of volunteers for making the Association's annual summer Regatta a big success. We're on track to continue with this popular SLAPOA event, as well as the Annual Sail Boat race and to build on both of them - possibly via an end-of-summer BBQ/Corn Roast, so stay tuned for more details.

I've had the good fortune of spending countless time during the spring, summer and autumn at Sand Lake over the course of my life (I was actually born in Huntsville while my family lived at Sand Lake); despite that, I know there are still so many people I have not had the opportunity to meet, and many more whose contributions to the community go unrecognized. With this in mind, I would like to say to all of those people who have given so generously of their time, energy and resources to our beloved Sand Lake Area: my sincere thanks for all that you have done and continue to do in making Sand Lake special to all of us.
